


How Grocers are Using Self Check-Out Devices to Improve Front End Operations

- Connective Hardware, having both the horizontal and vertical pieces of the scanner connected to avoid product slippage
- Produce Railing, to help keep the produce on the scanner when a customer is moving too fast through their basket
- Additional sensors on each side of the device, to <u>ensure no product code is forgotten</u>
- And lastly, having an attachment like a Top Down Imager (TDi) to help reduce the amount of shrink by effortlessly detecting products with a built in camera

Instead of having your associate running from check-out to check-out offer them a remote management solution.
